Think about your strengths and the type of learner you are; for example do you prefer exams and/or coursework.


What are you predicted/actual grades?

Don't over-sell or under-sell yourself






Booking on to Open Days

Get an idea of how many universities you want to visit.

Think about where they are in the UK. Remember there are 125+ universities and colleges that will have open days that clash.

Discuss with family or friends if they are able to attend the fair with you.





Leading up to the open day

Check travel information – usually posted on university social media accounts or main websites.

Do you book overnight accommodation?

How far/close is the university from where you live?

Do you take the train, drive, coach or walk?

Will you have time to explore around the university?






Planning your day

Once you have booked on to the open day, the university will send you details of the day. Including a campus map, travel information and a programme of activities.

Make sure you check you are registered on the right open day date and know the correct campus you are attending as some universities have multiple sites.

Familiarise yourself with the campus layout and where you need to meet. Take note of the travel arrangements that are in place for the day.

Planning your day: Example Programme

The programme will also be sent to you in advance. This will give you an opportunity to see what is available to see and who you are able to meet from your specific department.

There will also be central talks on student finance, UCAS and a welcome and student life talk

Try and make the most of your day. This may only be the only time you visit the university before you apply on your UCAS application.

Is there a reading list?	Is there wi-fi available?




After you have visited...
