Dear Parent/Carer,

Warwickshire Music Instrumental Lessons

Warwickshire Music teachers have returned to in-school teaching to deliver face-to-face instrumental and vocal lessons. We have adopted a phased approach and agreed social distancing measures with each individual school to ensure the continued safety of our teachers and pupils.

If you would like your child to have instrumental or vocal lessons during school hours, from week beginning 16 November onwards, you will need to enrol by clicking <u>"Enrol Today</u>" here or on the right-hand side of our website <u>warwickshiremusichub.org</u>.

When prompted select "School" followed by selecting the name of your child's school from the dropdown list.

N.B - If you do not already have an account you will need to create one.

We also offer instrument hire, which is free for the first year of learning per pupil. Students must be having tuition with Warwickshire Music to be eligible for this. Please click <u>Hire an Instrument</u> here or on the right-hand side of our website <u>warwickshiremusichub.org</u> for further information and to submit your instrument hire application.

If you experience any difficulties enrolling your child, please email <u>music@warwickshire.gov.uk</u> and we will endeavour to assist you further.

Under normal circumstances, payment would be in advance for a whole term. Due to current pandemic restrictions and regular changes to advice and guidance, we have decided to bill parents in arrears for the autumn term based on the number of lessons delivered to individual pupils. In the event of local lock downs, school closures or bubbles/individuals having to self-isolate, lessons may be deliverable remotely dependent on teacher availability.

If your son/daughter is currently having online lessons with Warwickshire Music and you would like for them to switch to face-to-face tuition, please discuss this with your child's instrumental teacher in the first instance to arrange this.

Current pricing for online/face-to-face tuition is:

- Individual 30 minute lesson: £20
- Individual 20 minute lesson: £13.50
- Shared 30 minute lesson: £10
- Shared 20 minute lesson: £6.75

If a shared lesson is not available, your child may be offered a lesson at half the duration or a fortnightly lesson, until a suitable pairing becomes available.

When you have enrolled you will then be contacted by Warwickshire Music to confirm the arrangements for instrumental lessons.
