## Fine Art Textiles CURRICULUM CONTENT (KS3) Year 8

The Year 8 Carousel gives students the opportunity to study Art textiles in a 6-7 week module each term.

#### **Autumn Term**

- Introduction to using the sewing machine safely.
- Practise straight stitching and parallel lines.
- Create a detailed patchwork panel with layered fabrics and decorative machine embroidery.
- Learn how to make cord.
- Make a needle case with button and fastening.

#### **Key Assessments**

- Quality of sewing on patchwork.
- Regular evaluation and feedback on work as it develops.
- Assessed homework piece exploring the work of a textile artist.
- Neatness and design quality of needle case

# Extension Activities to become involved with.

- Assist in gathering resources for more individual outcome.
- Look at websites: and create Pinterest board of textiles items to provide ideas for the future.
- Watch craft and fashion programmes like the Sewing Bee, documentaries and clips on YouTube.

### **Spring Term**

- Record landscape views using linear pen technique.
- Design proposals for wet felted landscape panel in pen and wash.
- Introduction to natural fibres, silk, wool and sari thread.
- Create a wet felt panel.
- Embroider into with range of threads,

### **Key Assessments**

Research sketches and resource gathering

- Assessed homework based on an artist study of felt artist.
- Assessment of felt panel, range of stitches and embellishments.
