Home/School Agreement

We recognise that learning is a three way partnership between students, parents and teachers. This agreement is intended to clarify at the start of a student's education what parents and students can expect of the school and what the school's expectations are of them. 1. The School

- provide a balanced curriculum suitable for students in this selective school;
- set, mark and monitor homework as outlined in the School's Homework Policy;
- provide opportunities for your daughter to take part in a wide variety of extra-curricular activities;
- be open and welcoming, keep you informed about general school matters and give you opportunities to participate in school events;
- communicate regularly about your daughter's progress and arrange Parents' Evenings as a part of this process;
- discuss with you any concerns or problems that affect your daughter's attendance, work or behaviour.

2. The Parent(s)

I/We shall endeavour to:

- ensure that my/our daughter goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped, wearing the correct school uniform and is neat and tidy in appearance;
- support the school's policies and procedures and reiterate the importance of good behaviour;
- support my/our daughter in homework and other opportunities for home learning;
- attend Parents' Evenings and discussions about my/our daughter's progress;
- take an interest in my/our daughter's life at school and encourage her to play an active part in the many extra-curricular activities offered;
- communicate with the school about any concerns or problems that may affect my/our daughter's work or behaviour;
- monitor my/our daughter's use of internet sites and social media to ensure no inappropriate or unpleasant messages are sent or received and commit to a time during which digital media/phones are switched off.

3. The Student

I shall endeavour to:

- attend school regularly and on time, bringing all the equipment I need every day;
- wear the correct uniform and be tidy in my appearance;
- do all my class work and homework in a timely manner;
- make the most of the opportunities offered at school, both academic and extra-curricular;
- be polite and helpful and show respect and tolerance towards others;
- conform to the expected code of behaviour for the school as outlined in the School Behaviour Policy;
- uphold the school's reputation in the wider community by behaving in a responsible and mature manner at all times, on or off the school premises
