FAQs

Q: Can I wear strappy tops?

A: No, you must wear a blouse or shirt of your choice .

Q: What sort of trousers can I wear?

A: Any suit trousers, but not shorts.

Q: What sort of skirt can I wear?

A: skirts should be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee and should not be made of a tight or clingy material. A pencil skirt is ideal and should match your suit jacket. Patterned skirts are not part of the dress code.

Q: Can I wear a dress?

A: No . Dresses are not allowed for Year 12 students

Q: Are there any colour restrictions?

A: The suit must be sensible and business like and can be navy, black, grey, tweed or pinstripe

Q: Am I allowed any denim?

A: No! Denim or jean-like materials are not allowed.

Q: Do I have to wear a suit jacket?

A: Yes, a suit jacket is compulsory .

Q: What style of top can I wear?

A: A shirt or blouse in any colour and fabric apart from denim, lace or sheer material.

Final Points:

- ◆ Hair must be a natural colour, it can be dyed but not blue, pink, etc.
- ◆ Jewellery and makeup are allowed.

What you *can*

wear...

- ◆ A business suit
- A shirt or blouse which can be patterned and in any colour you like.
- A tie can be worn
- Smart cardigan or jumper may be worn under the suit
- Footwear must be leather or made from a leather look or suede material.

What you *can't*

wear...

- ◆ No Ugg boots, trainers, 'biker', boots, sandals or canvas shoes.
- ◆ The shirt or blouse must not be denim, lace or sheer material and must not be too low cut.
