Although we cannot give you a complete breakdown of every activity (we usually organise over 90 trips per academic year), we thought it would be helpful to give you a flavour of the **residential trips** that we usually offer:

Bushcraft Residential (usually in June)

Classics trip to either Greece or Naples (July)

Homestay visit alternating to either France or Spain (February)

World Challenge (usually July & August)

Physics trip to CERN, Geneva (July)
